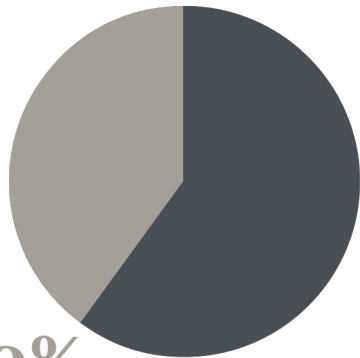

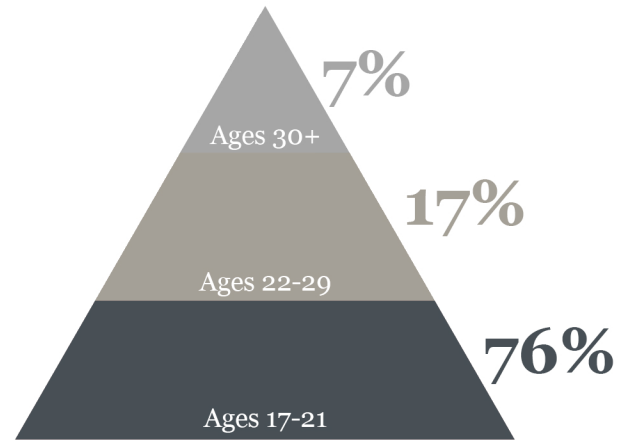

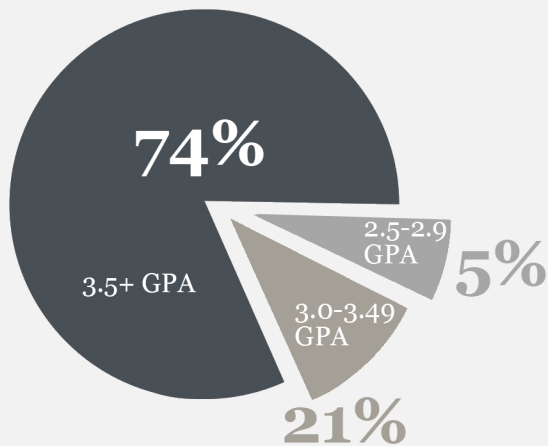

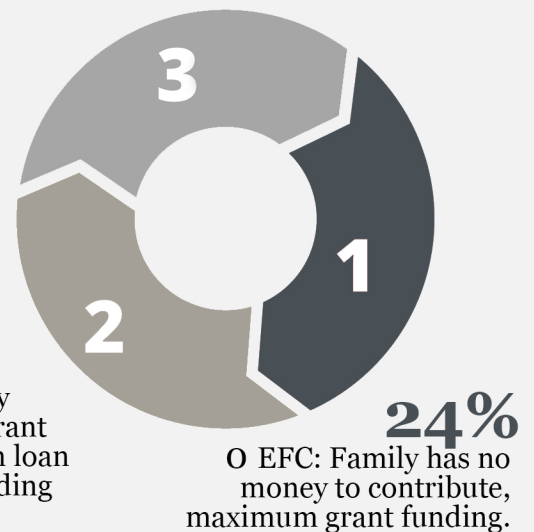
Stars Scholarship Fund provides scholarships to students of every level of higher education and field of study. We award students from our community of any gender, any ethnicity, any age, any religion, and any background.



Stars Scholarship Fund recipients represent academically talented and highly motivated students from the community, with 95% of scholarship recipients maintaining a 3.0 GPA or higher.

Of the 702 students receiving a scholarship for the 2021-2022 academic year, 54% are Pell Grant Eligible and thus deemed financially in need by the United States Department of Education. These students are offered partial grant funding to pay tuition. 46% of our recipients only qualify for self-help aid and must rely on federal loans to fund their education.
