



2022-2023 Recipient Demographics


Only 4 out of every 10 eligible applicants received a scholarship

Stars Scholarship Fund recipients represent academically talented and highly motivated students from the community, with 95% of scholarship recipients maintaining a 3.0 GPA or higher.



Of the 714 students receiving a scholarship for the 2022-2023 academic year, 61% are Pell Grant Eligible and thus deemed financially in need by the United States Department of Education. These students are offered partial grant funding to pay tuition. 39% of our recipients only qualify for self-help aid and must rely on federal loans to fund their education.
