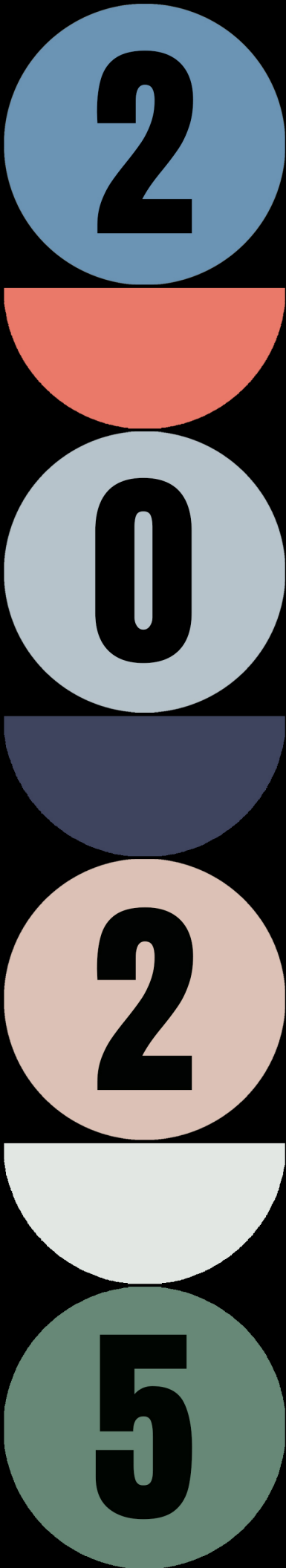

COMEDIAN STEVE TREVINO



“America’s Favorite Husband”

Comedian Steve Treviño is “America’s Favorite Husband.” He can “speak wife fluently,” he never calls “the guys” for help on a home project, and he knows better than to “make his own decisions,” since decision-making is a privilege reserved solely for his wife, Renae.

His relatable approach affirms his status as one of the country’s premiere stand-up comedians, viewed over 300 million times, selling-out shows across the nation, and amassing over 3.4 million total social media followers.

Today, the comedian has had stand-up specials with Amazon, NETFLIX, Showtime to name few. His first Showtime special, Grandpa Joe’s Son, staked out a spot in the Nielsen Top 20 when it first premiered. From the success of that special, he funded, produced, and shot his 2014 NETFLIX hit Relatable. To promote the special, he uploaded a clip titled “When Your Wife Comes Home From Shopping.” It exploded, generating over 56 million views on Facebook alone and paving the way for his other viral clips like “When You Ask Your Wife If She Wants McDonald’s” (21 million views). In 2018, Trevino released the follow-up special, Steve Trevino ‘Til Death on Amazon. In 2022, he once again self-produced his fifth special, I Speak Wife that released on YouTube garnering over 4 million views. Steve recently filmed his highly anticipated sixth special at The Tobin Center in San Antonio, which was directed by Renae Treviño. The special will premiere on Netflix in early 2024.

In honor of Treviño’s achievements in entertainment and comedy, the city of San Antonio presented the comedian with their prestige Emissary of the Muses certificate on November 24th, 2023.

In 2020, he and his wife, Renae, unveiled a joint weekly podcast entitled “Steve Treviño and Captain Evil.” On the podcast, the couple navigate the treacherous topics of relationships, family and stand-up comedy. All while trying to stay married. Since launching, the podcast has generated over 1.5 million views/streams.

He regularly raises money for Helicopters for Heroes, an organization benefiting veterans, for whom he helped raise over \$1.5 million in the past two years.

Steve lives in New Braunfels, TX with Captain Evil and their son and daughter. He will be kicking off his new tour, The Good Life in 2024.

Investing in Mental Health: A Bold New Initiative

“Every barrier we remove brings us one step closer to a community where mental health services are accessible and effective for all.”

Stars Scholarship Fund and the LaMantia Family have launched a multi-year initiative to address the shortage of Licensed Clinical Social Workers (LCSWs) in underserved communities.

This program provides financial and logistical support to MSW graduates pursuing licensure as LCSWs.

The goal is to produce culturally and linguistically competent mental health professionals rooted in South and West Texas.

Program Impact

Education Support

- Covers 80% of LCSW supervision costs
- Includes licensing exam fee
- Leverages university faculty as board-approved supervisors

Community Benefit

- 36 students per cohort
- First programs at UTRGV, starting Fall 2024 and UTEP, starting Spring 2025
- Addresses critical provider shortages in the Rio Grande Valley and El Paso

Why It Matters:

- National ratio: 1 provider per 320 residents
- El Paso County: 1 per 810 residents
- Over \$13,000 average cost to become an LCSW, a major financial barrier

\$130,000 gifted to each pilot university to launch program



Covers 100 hours of supervision by a licensed Texas LCSW supervisor required per student
